Hosting your own website with Pacnet can provide your business with invaluable and cost-effective exposure online. Recommended for companies who wish to establish corporate identity on the Internet or enhance their corporate image online, Pacnet Domain Service lets you reserve your unique domain name before someone else does. Reserve any new domain, or bring a domain name you already own to us and you can host it at Pacnet.

HOW DOES DOMAIN NAME WORK?

Domain name hosting comprises of two procedures

- 1) **The registration of the domain name with SGNIC (for .Com.SG domains) or InterNIC (for Dot.Com domains)**

SGNIC

The locations that domain names are pointed to are determined by Internet organisations known as Network Information Centres, or NICs. NICs are the authorities through which all domain names must be registered before they can be used on the Internet. In Singapore, Pacnet works exclusively with SGNIC (the NIC for Singapore domains), through direct contact, to register your .Com.SG domain names. As an additional service, when you register through Pacnet, your domain name will be hosted on our DNS servers.

If you would like to have a non-Singapore (.com) domain name (such as other country-specific, international domain or the InterNIC dot-Com domain), Pacnet can host it for you with no restriction to having a Dot.ORG or Dot.NET domains. Alternatively, we can help to register and host your domain name with any Pacnet office in Australia, Hong Kong, India or Thailand.

2) Hosting of your domain name at Pacnet state-of-the-art DNS servers

DNS Hosting

DNS hosting literally refers to the ability of one system to host multiple domains. When you host your domain name with us, our system from that point recognises requests for that domain and serves the appropriate pages to the internet users around the globe. This is the part of domain name hosting that Pacnet handles. You do not have to setup or maintain your own DNS servers, or employ an Internet engineer to maintain the DNS servers, Pacnet will do that for you.

Having a domain name allows you to

- Access your corporate website at <http://www.Your-Company-Name.com.sg>
- Access your website with subdomains, such as <http://products.Your-Company-Name.com.sg>
- Create email addresses such as user@your-company-name.com.sg
- Print your personalised email address and website address on your name cards
- Reserve your domain name and prevent it from being registered by another party

Accredited by Singapore Network Information Centre (SGNIC) to operate as a Domain Name Registrar for the registration of all Singapore domains (.SG), Pacnet helps you register your own unique domain name effortlessly using any of the following country code top level domains:

com.sg	For commercial units registered with the Registry of Companies & Businesses or any professional bodies.
org.sg	For non-profit organisations registered with the Registry of Societies including non-profit organisations such as embassies and town councils.
net.sg	For local network providers with a valid license issued by the Info-Communications Development Authority (IDA).
edu.sg	For Institutions registered with MOE (Ministry of Education).
